The Board must protect the civility and decorum of this meeting. Please be respectful for the duties of the Board and the democratic process in your comments tonight.

1. Please state your name and address, and address your comments to the Board.
2. Please limit your comments to 3 minutes.
3. Please be factual and courteous, and the Board requests that you not make statements that are personally disrespectful or condescending to members of the Board or staff.

To the extent multiple speakers are addressing a single issue, the Board President reserves the right to limit the number of speakers making public comment of a repetitive nature and/or limit the amount of time for public comment.

The Board typically does not respond to comments or attempt to answer questions during the public comment period.
